POINT TO PONDER: At the end of Eucharist services we hear a blessing and at 10am the final words are a dismissal: 'Go now to love and serve the Lord. Go in peace.' With these words we are ALL called up to be involved in Christ's mission to the world. Having worshipped, having received the nourishment of both Word and Sacrament and having enjoyed fellowship together, we are ready to GO in Christ's name. 'Amen. We go in the name of Christ.'
