### **Programme notes on the Organ Voluntary**

Bach's Fugue in Eb (the subtitle St. Anne coming from the hint of the hymn tune to "O God our help in ages past") is a 3 part fugue in celebration of the Trinity. Three themes gradually interweave and combine for the final section of the work which dances along to a powerful climax.
